



## WEST MONROE POLICE DEPARTMENT CITIZEN'S POLICE ACADEMY APPLICATION

The West Monroe Police Department Citizen's Police Academy is a ten-week program. It is held once a week from 6:00 pm to 8:30 pm. The academy consists of an introduction on the various components of the police department. Each topic is introduced by members and associates of the department who specialize in the topic being presented. The topics include Patrol Operations, Investigations (Detectives), Crime Scene, K-9, SWAT, 9-1-1, Mental Health and Illness, and DWI Investigations. There will be an option to participate in a ride along during the academy.

The purpose and mission of the Citizen's Police Academy is to foster better understanding between citizens and police through education so they may possess greater insight into police practices and the services provided. **There is no financial cost to attend the academy.**

### REQUIREMENTS:

Participants must:

- Be at least 18 years old
- Not have been convicted of a felony
- Not be on probation
- Understand a background check will be conducted
- Be willing to commit to the ten weeks
